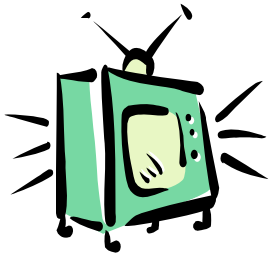


Before Transporting Hazardous Waste to your Collection Center--
follow these safety guidelines:

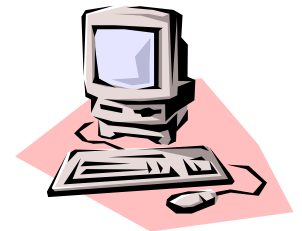
- The waste is in its original container and properly labeled.
- The contents of the container are the same as stated on the label.
- If not the same contents as labeled, cover up the label, and write the name of its contents.
- The container is sound, not leaking, and sealed.
- The amount of waste transported does not exceed 5 gallons or 50 pounds.
- Wastes are placed securely in the vehicle for safe transport.
